



Loxapine Succinate



MOA-Loxapine's antipsychotic action is likely mediated through a combination of antagonistic effects at D2 receptors in the mesolimbic pathway and 5-HT_{2A} receptors in the frontal cortex. D2 antagonism relieves positive symptoms while 5-HT_{2A} antagonism alleviates negative symptoms.

Uses-For use in patients with treatment-resistant schizophrenia.


Clozapine
